Tidewell Treasures is both a significant source of funding to Tidewell Foundation as well as an outreach program to inform people about the Foundation and its support of Tidewell Hospice.

With locations in Sarasota and Venice, the resale stores reach thousands of donors and patrons each year.

The stores welcome donations of gently used furniture, clothing and household items, which are then placed for sale in the store.

The stores are "resale" stores because of their focus on high quality items. Not all donations are accepted. The objective is to obtain the highest possible price in support of making grants back to Tidewell Hospice.

Volunteers accept, sort, price, display and sell the donated items.

"Staff and volunteers take a great deal of pride in our stores," said Deborah Kenny, who manages the Venice Treasures, a Venice-fixture for more than 10 years. "Because we know the more successful we are, the more we can help support hospice patients and families."

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said Delesa Morris, Interim President. "In addition, by supporting workforce programs, we are developing a talented, dedicated team of caregivers to serve the community now and into the future."

Many Tidewell programs, including free grief care and complementary services, are made possible only

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because of donor support.

Donations also allow Tidewell to expand and enhance programs as needed.

Awards \$4.5 Million in Grants Empath Health

The following programs were funded by grants made by the Tidewell Foundation in Fiscal Year 2022:

Pediatric Care Services **\$60,795**

Tidewell Hospice provides free care to children with advanced illness, including support to help their families navigate the most difficult days of their lives.

Tidewell Honors Veterans Program **\$53,749**

This comprehensive program focuses on respectfully celebrating veterans and providing care that recognizes the unique challenges that may exist in military families.

Blue Butterfly Program **\$621,824**

Tidewell's Blue Butterfly is an evidence-based community outreach program for children aged 5-18 and their caregivers who have experienced the death of a significant person in their lives.

Community Grief Center **\$602,492**

The Tidewell Family Grief Center in Ellenton is a first-of-itskind facility in the region that provides holistic grief support for individuals, families, and the community.

Grief Education and Support Services \$676,351

Tidewell Hospice is the most significant provider of free grief counseling programs in its fourcounty service area.

Cardiac Care Program **\$146,135**

The Advanced Cardiac Care Program caters to patients with end-stage heart failure and helps them manage symptoms and concerns from the comfort of their homes.

Nurse Residency Program **\$511,530**

This unique training course, launched in 2018, provides recent Registered Nurse graduates with a year-long, in-depth training program in hospice nursing.

Home Health Aide Training Program \$38,240

This program trains home health aides in the hospice specialty, helping to fill a community need amid nationwide worker shortages.

Complementary Services \$415,957

Tidewell Complementary Services offers a full array of special programs that bring quality of life to those with advanced illness through stress reduction, pain relief and distraction, opportunities for joy, and healing of psycho-social issues for patients and their families.

Humanitarian & Wishes Fund **\$90,000**

The Humanitarian Fund grants emergency, non-medical financial relief, alleviating that burden on a patient or caregiver and allowing them to focus on their medical care. The Tidewell Foundations' Wishes Fund fulfills a last wish for Tidewell Hospice patients and their families.

Free Care \$950,000

At the heart of Tidewell's mission is the belief that everyone deserves access to world-class hospice care, regardless of their ability to pay. Tidewell has a special fund to ensure that compassion, comfort and care are available to all who need it.

Signature Luncheon Honors Veterans

The Tidewell Foundation Signature Luncheon returns for its 14th year with a salute to our **U.S. Veterans**, featuring nationally recognized speaker, retired Army Major and Bronze Star recipient, **Dr. Sudip Bose**.

As an Army battalion surgeon in the Iraq War, Dr. Bose was selected to treat Saddam Hussein after his capture and was awarded a Bronze Star for completing one of the longest combat tours by any physician since World War II. He's been recognized as a "CNN Hero" and was named one of the "Leading Physicians of the World" by the International Association of Healthcare Professionals.

From the front lines of emergency rooms in the pandemic and combat zones in Iraq,

Dr. Bose has an inspiring and motivational message. "His personal story of bravery, overcoming challenges and applying those lessons to help countless people will keep people riveted," said Delesa Morris, Interim President, Tidewell Foundation.

Signature Luncheon brings together more than 800 people in the community and benefits the many services of Tidewell Hospice and other Empath Health not-for-profit entities.
