At just 11 years old, L.T. dreamt of being the youngest person to sail around the world. Her mother enrolled her in a sailing camp, and she was on her way. No one could have anticipated that L.T.'s dream would become a nightmare when she witnessed a friend's tragic

death during practice on the water. At a recent fundraising event at Café Barbosso in Sarasota, she shared her Tidewell Story for the first time with the public:

Never putting your hands up "For the longest time I blamed myself. I'd been his helper that day. His teacher. Even when I was. He was my responsibility. I remember my first session with ~L.T. Miss Lendy. I swore to myself that I would never share with anyone, ever, other than Miss Lendy. But when she finally got me to open up, I don't regret letting her finally open the floodgates."

L.T.'s mom is grateful for finding the Tidewell Blue Butterfly Family Grief Program, which she calls

"a powerful, crucial, life changing, grief mending program with significant impact for children that are dealing with death in their lives."

She says of her daughter, "With the valuable guidance of the Tidewell Blue Butterfly program she is receiving the tools, the support, Thank you the validation to grieve, process,
